Puppy Dog (3) **1 Tate's I Can Boogie At Jaeva NAF TAF:** 7 months old, very promising red, good head, nice strong muzzle and good teeth, bright sparkling dark oval eyes, nice ears, good neck and front, nice body bone and rib, coat coming well, well-made hindquarters, moved and showed well, competent handling got the best out of him. Best Puppy Dog. **2 Thompson-Morgan's Belleville Ice Cool Cloud:** 6 months old, not as mature as my winner, I preferred this boys head, excellent body, very smart on the move with a level short back, I like his tail carriage I am sure these two quality puppies will change places many times.

Junior Dog (2) **1 Gee's Watercroft Tea Leaf:** Red, compact dog with a strong head, super scissor bite, dark oval eyes, good expression and neat set ears, a good length of neck and well laid shoulders good depth of body, excellent alert temperament and moved with drive.

Post Graduate Dog (3) **1 Davis' Watercroft Earl Grey:** Red, well-proportioned dog, with good bite, large teeth and dark eyes, compact body well covered body, excellent black pigmentation, moved well and maintained level topline.

Open Dog (4) **1 Gee's Watercroft Boozy Miller:** Red, mature dog with a strong broad head, correct scissor bite, short and compact body as were all from this kennel, moved well, excellent harsh coat. Best Dog & Best Opposite Sex. **2 Thompson-Morgan's Belleville High Life:** Compact dog with an alert expression, strong head and muzzle, good ears which he used well, true front, level topline, moved and showed well, I just preferred the body of the winner. Two lovely dogs. Reserve Best Dog.

Puppy Bitch (3) **1 Gee's Watercroft On Your Marks:** Very showy alert little bitch, enjoying every moment in the ring, good head and ears, well balanced body, good front and tail set, moved and showed with a look at me attitude. Best Bitch Puppy & Best Puppy In Breed. **2 Thompson-Morgan's Belleville Secret Hopes:** Another quality exhibit, typical head and ears, excellent pigmentation well balanced right through, more coat and ruff would complete the picture and make her look more compact, moved and showed well.

Open Bitch (7) 1 Gee's Ch Watercroft Sticky Toffee: Excellent quality red bitch with lovely head, well set ears, good stop, dark eyes, correct bite, good front and shoulders, nice neck to well ribbed body, short backed with good set on, alert and on her toes, with excellent turn of stifle, double coat, moved true both ways, carrying a level topline, she took my eye soon as she entered the ring. Many thanks, firstly to the committee for the appointment and to the exhibitors for the entry. I found the quality was strong, with the girls strongest in depth. The lockdown must have prompted you all to get the toothbrushes out, because I never found one dirty mouth, in fact they were gleaming.

Puppy Dog (5) **1 Darnell's Jaquidon Hot Off The Press**: 6m old full of type, lovely head with dark eye and super dentition, just the right amount of bone and muscle for his young age, well angulated front and rear, with a level topline and strong loin, he moved out easily. BP. **2 Tate's I Can Boogie At Jaeva NAF TAF:** Another tidy youngster, nice shape in profile, good all round but just preferred the winners movement. **3 Brazier's Kinsridge Close To Midnight.**

Junior Dog (3) **1 Gee's Watercroft Tea Leaf:** Liked this boy a lot, his head was typical Norfolk, with a dark oval eye & and super ear carriage, shoulders well laid, with straight front and tight feet, nicely bodied with strong ribbing, rear quarters were strong with good angulation, presented with good jacket, on the move excelled with good reach and drive. One I'm sure for high honours. CC & BOB. Nice to see him in the cut for the group. **2 Smith's Javidel Maybach:** Nice type with appealing head and expression, felt a little too well bodied, it would help his balance and movement of he lost a bit

Post graduate Dog (2) 1 Powell's Watercroft Brown Boots: Pleasing outline with decent head shape, dark eye with good ear carriage, well bodied with good spring of rib, good quarters, moved out ok but would like to see more enthusiasm.

Limit Dog (3) 1 Thompson-Morgan's Belleville High Life: Quality boy throughout, appealing head & expression, good length of neck, well laid shoulders into straight front, deep well sprung ribs, level topline with strong well angulated rear quarters, presentation was superb, moved out with drive, really pushed the CC winner hard. RCC. 2 Atkinson's Moortop Mymark Again: Another lovely type, typical head shape with dark oval eye and good mouth, quarters were well angulated with decent bone and muscle, strong in back with good loin. Coat was presented nicely, moved out strongly.

Open Dog (4) **1 Gee's Watercroft Boozy Miller:** Another lovely type, typical head with dark eye. Straight front with good lay of shoulder, deep well sprung rib with muscular loin, short in back, rear quarters well-muscled with super angulation, handled and presented well. **2 Smith's Javidel Despicable May:** Another typy dog, all the attributes of 1, but I just preferred the pace and gait of the first

Puppy Bitch (4) **1 Jenkins' Kinsridge Songbird:** 6m old, sweetest head and expression, I know that things can change, but everything about her is just right at this age, hopefully that will carry on as she develops, moving was a good game for her, and she took advantage of it. **2 Thompson-Morgan's Belleville Secret Hopes:** Another 6m baby with sweet head and expression, same attributes as the first, and I'm sure these two will swap round many times. **3 Gee's Watercroft On Your Marks**

Junior Bitch (7) 1 Gee's Watercroft Gold Leaf: Yet another beautiful girl from this kennel, so balanced throughout, feminine head and expression, quarters correctly angulated with good firm muscle, well bodied with firm backline, coat was bang on, on the move she was loving it with her super driving action, she pushed the dog hard for the top honour. CC. 2 Atkinson's Moortop Bobby's Girl: Lovely cobby youngster with feminine head and expression, quality throughout, still seemed very much a baby, give her a couple of months, and I think she will blossom nicely. 3 Jones' Javidel May Blessing At Darlaur

Post Graduate Bitch (4) 1 Smith's Javidel May I Present: Prettiest head and expression, dark oval eye, teeth, well what do we say, best mouth I've seen in a long time, her teeth were big but fitted her jaw perfectly, good front assembly with well laid shoulders, short level back into muscular rear, moved out easily with good driving action. 2 Thompson-Morgan's Belleville Secret Hopes. 3 Glynn's Kenberlynn Angels Dream

Limit Bitch (4) 1 Phillips' Blakens Look To The Stars: super cobby black and tan, her richly coloured jacket was in superb condition, prettiest of heads with dark knowing eyes, well-made quarters fore and aft, deep ribbing with muscular loin, her movement in profile was nice to watch, driving from the rear. RCC. 2 Jenkins' Kinsridge Tip Toes: Super type with such a pretty head, firm well-muscled throughout yet feminine in every way, coat in good order, moved out with drive. 3 Glynn's Kenberlynn Angels Spirit

I would like to thank the committee for the honour of judging this breed at the show and the exhibitors for the time and effort put into to producing this breed for show. My thanks too in keeping the ring running on time to my able stewards Mrs A Salmon & Mrs L Malthouse.

Veteran Dog (1) **1 Brown's Dajean Dotty's Digger**: A super dog showing the true temperament of this breed, happily showing his socks off. Good head, level topline, good body condition. Not as compact in body shape as he could be.

Puppy Dog (4) **1 Gee's Watercroft Neat And Dandy**: Beautifully balanced dog. I & 2 had good strength and length of muzzle, good head shape, dark eye. Lovely forequarters cobby body. Tail on top. Very good rear quarters. In excellent coat. Moved well. **2 Darnell's Jaquidon Hot Off The Press**: Similar to 1, lovely neck and shoulders. Moved steady and showed well. **3 Tate's I Can Boogie At Jaeva NAF TAF.**

Junior Dog (1) **1 Smith's Javidel Maybach:** Smart jacket. Good head and neat ears. Good fore-quarters, spring of rib good, and length of back. Lovely rear angulation good steady movement.

Post Graduate Dog (5) **1 Thompson-Morgan's Belleville Expectation:** Super B&T. Lovely for size, super head wedge shaped muzzle, lovely length of neck leading onto well place shoulders. Good depth of chest, cobby body, level topline, good tail set. Moved so smoothly. **2 Jenkins's Kinsridge Talking Point:** Super coated red dog. Short backed and cobby on good legs and feet. Good head. Moved well happily showing off. **3 Smith's Javidel Maybach.**

Limit Dog (5) 1 Gee's Watercroft Tea Leaf: Good headed dog, slightly rounded skull. Dark eye, good strong muzzle, neat ears, excellent expression. very good fore-quarters, level topline, good rear. Beautiful red jacket. Settled to move into 1st place. RCC. 2 Simpson's Brickin Wish Me Luck at Megalex: Happy free standing chap. Liked his head, super muzzle, neat ears and dark eye. Good shoulders, short back, cobby body, good rear angulation. Moved soundly. 3 Nash's Ralph of House Nash

Open Dog (7) **1 Gee's Ch Watercroft Boozy Miller:** Excellent topline kept on the move. Super stamp of dog. Lovely head with kind expression, good neck and shoulders, deep chest, powerful rear used to advantage on the move. Shown in pristine condition. CC. **2 Thompson-Morgan's Belleville High Life:** A quality dog who came to life once the placings were handed out! Handsome head on super neck and shoulders, good front, and rear, moved well. Preferred the topline of 1. **3 Smith's Ch. Javidel Despicable May**

Good Citizen Dog Scheme Dog (1) 1 Brown's Dajean Dotty's Digger.

Veteran Bitch (3) 1 Lazenby's Ch Allright Black Bess (Imp Deu): Feminine B&T who reminded me of one mine. Good head with a varminty expression, deep chest, cobby body, short back, good spring of rib. Smart coat in good condition, striding out well. BV. 2 Macartney's Nordalset Little Bit Of Sun For Ivrig VW: Slightly longer cast than 1, with a longer muzzle to her otherwise good head, at nearly 10 years old carrying excellent body weight. Moving well, enjoying herself.

Puppy Bitch (2) 1 Thompson-Morgan's Belleville Secret Hopes: 2 lovely red bitches of whom I am sure will have many challenges together. Beautiful feminine head, dark sparkling eyes, wedge shaped muzzle, lovely neck, shoulders, level topline, good spring to rib. Excellent rear, lovely driving movement, super coat in excellent condition. Overall such a balanced picture at this age I shall watch her with interest. BP. 2 Jenkins's Kinsridge Songbird: Love this girl's outline and so positive on the move. Beautiful coat in excellent condition, just preferred head properties of 1.

Junior Bitch (8) **1 Stevenson's Brickin Dare To Dream:** A good class! 3 similar girls fighting for top spot. Lovely head with a kindly expression. Clean in neck and shoulders, deep chest, short back, well sprung, good rear, moved and showing well. **2 Devereux's Vichea Dancing Shadow:** She grew in confidence as the class went on, good head varminty but feminine expression. Good for size, liked her shape, lovely coat of great texture. Moved very well. **3 Atkinson's Moortop Bobby's Girl.**

Post Graduate Bitch (5) **1 Smith's Javidel May I Present:** Please forgive my short critique on the following classes as my recorder had stopped recording so relying on my memory!! Presents a super outline, good front quarters, deep chest short level back, strong rear quarters, moved out with purpose. **2 Hess & Higgins's Umbrage Special Delivery**: A smart bitch who presented well on the table, however came alive on the move, she flowed around the ring smoothly and effortlessly. **3 Price's Umbrage Red Van.**

Limit Bitch (7) 1 Gee's Watercroft Gold Leaf: Out of the same stable with all the same qualities, namely good head properties, excellent neck and shoulders, well sprung ribbing, short back, powerful rear quarters, moving soundly and showed sympathetically by handler in the challenge to beat off 2nd in open and a smart puppy! RCC. 2 Phillips's Blakens Look To The Stars: Smart B&T with good bone and substance. Deep chest, & strong rear quarters, moved well. 3 Nash's Tiggy Of House Nash

Open Bitch (7) 1 Gee's Ch Watercroft Pink Fizz: What a super model! Loved her for size. Feminine head but with good width, strong muzzle, almond shaped kind dark eye, neat ears. A powerhouse of a body, forequarters short, hindquarters well-muscled, cobby body and level topline. Shown in excellent coat and body condition. Showing like a dream. Have given her a RCC before so pleased to see she has fulfilled her early promise. CC BOB. 2 Thompson-Morgan's Belleville Natural High: Free moving bitch with a very pretty head. Super neck and shoulders level topline. Short back good tail set. I would like to thank the committee of the National Dog Show for inviting me to judge the breed today, I had a very enjoyable day, and thank you to my very efficient stewards who kept the ring running nicely. I would also like to thank the exhibitors for their entries, there were many quality dogs and bitches entered making some decisions very difficult and some very promising youngsters.

Special Beginners Dog (3) **1 Harrison's Jacquidon Rich Tea:** A 10 month old who needs closer inspection to appreciate his virtues, he is well put together, balanced and in proportion, head of the correct proportions, dark eyes, and the correct bite. Well laid shoulders and upper arms, short back and a level topline, nicely angulated rear quarters and he moved soundly, it will be interesting to see how he develops, well handled, and presented, Best Special Beginners. **2 Powell's Watercroft Brown Boots:** A two and a half year old and larger than the first placed dog, head and skull correct, well set ears, correct length of muzzle and correct bite. I would prefer more layback of shoulders,

coat texture good, level topline, correct tail carriage, movement was true and sound. 3 McFadden's Watercroft Spotted Dick.

Minor Puppy Dog (4) 1 Thompson-Morgan's Belleville Plum Picker: At almost 9 months old a lively puppy with attitude, well-constructed, head of the correct proportions, dark eyes, and the correct bite. Neck well set on and shoulders well laid back, level topline, correct coat texture, nicely angulated rear quarters and he moved with drive and purpose, Best Puppy Dog and Best Puppy. 2 Britten's Krisma Snap Chat: An 8 month old, masculine and well developed, head of the correct proportions, ears well set on, strong muzzle and the correct bite. Correct coat texture, nicely angulated front and rear, level topline and the correct tail set, moved soundly but just preferred the overall movement of the first placed dog.

Puppy Dog (4) 1 Darnell's Jaquidon Hot Off The Press: A 10 month old, masculine and showing the correct breed type, balanced and in proportion, correct coat texture, head and skull well developed, strong muzzle, dark eyes, and the correct bite. Strong neck, well laid back shoulders, level topline and a deep chest, ribs carried well back and nicely angulated rear quarters, his movement was sound and true. 2 Harrison's Jacquidon Rich Tea. 3 Tate's I Can Boogie At Jaeva NAF TAF.

Post Graduate Dog (4) 1 Thompson-Morgan's Belleville Expectation: A 21 month old B/T, little shown but a quality youngster, showing the correct breed type, balanced outline, and the correct proportions throughout, broad skull, wedge shaped muzzle, dark eyes, and the correct bite. Well laid shoulders and upper arms, deep chest and a well sprung ribcage, ribs carried well back, correct tail set and strong rear quarters, low set hocks, he moved soundly with reach and drive, a very promising youngster and well deserving of the CC today. 2 Mullen's Watercroft Pop Muzik At Tamodan: A 3 year old, R/W, smaller than the first placed dog and I would prefer a little more size and substance, good proportions and balanced, head good, dark eyes and the correct bite. Level topline, deep chest coat of the correct texture, nicely angulated front, and rear quarters, he moved soundly. 3 Powell's Watercroft Brown Boots.

Limit Dog (3) 1 Simpson's Brickin Wish Me Luck At Megalex: A three and a half year old R/W with the correct head proportions, dark eyes and the correct bite and dentition, coat of the correct texture, well laid shoulders and a deep chest ribcage carried well back. Level topline, I would have preferred a little more bend of stifle, but he moved with a lively gait. 2 Jenkins' Kinsridge Talking Point: A two and a half year old R/W, typical outline, balanced and in proportion, masculine head, dark eyes and the correct bite and dentition, correct coat texture, strong neck, level topline, deep brisket, well sprung ribcage, and ribs carried well back. His movement was sound and true, and he moved soundly, but I would have preferred more reach in front.

Open Dog (3) 1 Smith's Ch Javidel Despicable May: A four and a half year old and good condition throughout, a typical and balanced outline, correct coat texture, broad skull, well set ears, strong muzzle, and the correct bite. Strong neck, well laid shoulders and upper arms, deep chest, ribs well sprung and carried well back strong loin, nicely angulated rear quarters and moved soundly showing reach and drive in profile, he pushed hard for the CC, but I just preferred the youthfulness and vibrancy of the CC winner, RCC. 2 Gee's Ch Watercroft Boozy Miller: A two and a half year old and another quality example of the breed, balanced throughout, typical head proportions, dark eyes and the correct bite and dentition. Strong neck, well laid shoulders, deep brisket, and a well sprung ribcage. Level topline and the correct coat texture, strong rear quarters and the correct bend of stifle, his movement was sound and true and showed reach and drive in profile. 3 Thompson-Morgan's Belleville High life.

Special Beginners Bitch (1) **1 Walker's Watercroft Golden Spice**: A two and a half year old bitch, feminine head proportions, dark eyes, bite could have been better, neck well set on, nicely angulated front and rear quarters, level topline, coat of the correct texture, she moved soundly coming and going.

Minor Puppy Bitch (5) **1 Gee's Watercroft Treacle Toffee:** A seven and a half month old, very feminine with a typical breed outline, balanced without exaggeration, nicely angulated front and rear quarters, head of the correct proportions, dark eyes, and the correct bite and dentition, deep chest, well sprung ribcage, level topline. Coat of the correct texture, her movement was sound and true, a very promising youngster. **2 Jenkins' Kinsridge Ha'penny:** A 7 month old who needs time to develop, feminine head, dark eyes, I would prefer a stronger muzzle, correct bite, and dentition. Correct coat texture, level topline, she moved soundly but I would prefer stronger rear quarters.

Puppy Bitch (3) **1 Jenkins' Kinsridge Songbird:** A 9 month old very promising puppy, balanced and in proportion with a lively disposition, head proportions correct, dark eyes, strong muzzle and the correct bite and dentition, neck well set on, well laid shoulders and a deep chest. Level topline, coat of the correct texture, nicely angulated rear quarters, and low set hocks, she moved well showing reach and drive in profile. **2 Feller's Belleville Hopes And Dreams:** An 11 month old with a balanced outline, head of the correct proportions with a feminine expression, dark eyes and the correct bite and dentition. Neck of the correct length, deep chest, and a level topline, coat of the correct texture. I would have preferred more length to her upper arms, and this affected her front movement when coming on.

Junior Bitch (4) 1 Tate's Jaeva What The Hell: A 16 month old B/T, she has a lovely typical breed outline, compact and strong, broad skull, well set ears and a dark eye, strong muzzle, neck well set on, well laid shoulders and upper arms, deep chest and well sprung ribcage, ribs carried well back. Level topline, correct coat texture and the correct turn of stifle, her movement was sound and positive, well presented and a promising youngster. 2 Stevenson's Brickin Dare To Dream: A 16 month old, and heavier than the first placed bitch, head of the correct proportions and typical expression, dark eyes and the correct bite, strong neck, nicely angulated front and rear quarters, deep chest, level topline and coat of the correct texture. She moved with a lively gait showing reach and drive in profile. 3 Gee's Watercroft Gin Fizz.

Yearling Bitch (3) 1 Jenkins' Kinsridge Tippy Toes: A 15 month old and a very promising youngster, showing a typical outline, balanced and in proportion, head showing the correct proportions, broad skull, strong muzzle, dark eyes and the correct bite and dentition, neck well set on, well laid shoulder blades and upper arms, deep brisket, well sprung ribcage, and ribs carried well back. Level topline and strong rear quarters with the correct bend of stifle and low set hocks. She moved soundly with reach and drive in profile, another very promising youngster, I was very pleased to award the RCC. 2 Gee's Watercroft In The Que: A 20 month old showing a typical outline, dark eyes, and the correct bite, I preferred the head of the first placed bitch, nicely angulated front and rear quarters, level topline, correct coat texture, her movement was a little erratic on the day. 3 Smith's Javidel Oh Me Oh May.

Post Graduate Bitch (2) **1 Thompson-Morgan's Belleville Secret Hopes:** An 11 month old, showing maturity for a young bitch, typical outline, feminine head and expression, dark eyes and the correct bite, ears well placed, neck of the correct length, well laid shoulders and a level topline, deep brisket, correct spring of rib and ribs carried well back. Nicely angulated rear quarters and low set hocks, her movement was sound and true, pleased to award her best puppy bitch. **2 Walker's Watercroft Golden Spice.**

Limit Bitch (3) 1 Gee's Watercroft On Your Marks: A 15 month old, another very typical example of the breed showing balance and being compact with a short back, level topline and nicely angulated front, and rear quarters. Broad skull, dark eyes, strong muzzle and the correct bite, well laid shoulders, deep chest, and well sprung ribcage. Her movement was sound and true showing reach and drive in profile. 2 Smith's Javidel May I Present: An 18 month old B/T, a young bitch showing balance in her front and rear quarters, level topline, deep chest and well sprung ribcage, broad skull, dark eyes and the correct bite, muzzle of the correct length, I just preferred the head of the first placed bitch, coat of the correct texture and well presented, she moved well, being sound and true. 3 Stevenson's Brickin Tell Me All.

Open Bitch (2) 1 Thompson-Morgan's Belleville Natural High: At almost 2 years old she impressed me immediately with her overall balance, breed type and a happy lively disposition, she is feminine but strong throughout, broad skull, ears set well apart, dark eyes and a strong wedge shaped muzzle. Strong neck, well laid shoulder blades and upper arms, good forechest, deep brisket and a well sprung ribcage, ribs carried well back. Strong rear quarters with the correct bend of stifle, and low set hocks, correct feet, her movement was sound and true coming and going and she showed reach and drive in profile, I had no hesitation in awarding her the CC and very pleased to find out that it was her third on the day, CC, and BOB. 2 Gee's Watercroft Gold Leaf: A 19 month old R/W, and a little smaller than the first placed bitch, typical outline, head of the correct proportions, dark eyes and the correct bite, and a strong muzzle. Neck of the correct length, well laid shoulders and a deep chest, well sprung ribs. Level topline, strong loin and nicely angulated rear quarters and low set hocks, her movement was sound but moving a little wide behind today.

Critique – Bath Canine Society

I must thank Bath Committee for the invitation to judge at their well-run Championship Show. I was supposed to judge this breed two years ago but am delighted today to have the opportunity. Having a nice entry within this lovely breed for my first time giving tickets, I was pleased with the quality and the numbers. I had some nice comments made about my judging and decisions.

Veteran Dog (1) 1 Nash's Ralph Of House Nash ShCEx: Just into 7 years old, this is a smart looking male. I liked his breed type having a lovely compact body with plenty of substance giving him correct depth. Masculine developed head of correct shape well set and carried ears, dark expressive eyes, stop, correct muzzle well furnished. Nice neck into well laid shoulders firm backline to correct set on tail. Well-presented wiry coat of correct texture and having undercoat. Nicely angulated front and rear. Short well boned legs and tight feet. Very sound free mover with happy tail carriage. Best Veteran. Delighted to see him win Best Terrier Veteran on the day.

Puppy Dog (2) 1 Gee's Watercroft Neat And Dandy: Very handsome 11 months youngster fills the standard nicely with well-developed and furnished head, neat well set and carried ears, kind alert dark eyes, good stop and muzzle and jaw. Head held well on a strong neck, clean into shoulders with firm broad backline with well rooted tail. Strong well ribbed body with substance and depth short loin. Good depth of chest and return of stifle both ends well angled. Lovely textured red coat having presentation and condition. Strong short well boned legs and tight round feet moved out soundly covering the ground. BPD. 2 Britten's Krisma Snap Chat: Correct head shape to this 9 month pup, not as forward as my winner but having 2 months of age difference. Ears well placed but not settled, expressive dark eyes, more stop needed. Short strong neck into well laid back shoulders, firm top line to well rooted tail carried with slight curl. Well bodied not as muscular as first, having depth and ribs well sprung back. Nicely presented in a harsh red textured coat. Well angled both ends, short well boned legs and tight feet. Good ground coverage.

Post Graduate Dog (2) 1 Mullan & McFadden's Watercroft Pop Muzik At Tamodan: Correctly shaped and balance to this smart small looking red wiry coated male. Correct size to this compact dog just carrying little weight today. Good broad skull with nice width between his ears. Nice wedge shape to his muzzle with good stop. Strong moderate neck with ruff, into well laid back shoulders and short level back, over well sprung body. Well angulated front and rear, short well boned legs and nicely rounded feet, Stylish sound mover nice front action and powerful rear. Nice tail carriage. 2 Davis' Watercroft Earl Grey: Nice looking but a slightly bigger dog than my winner and on-going over was carrying far too much weight. Masculine broad head, nice width between his well carried ears, nice eyebrows over dark eyes, and good stop. I would like more neck into his shoulders, enough angulation to his front, well ribbed body. Firm level backline nice tail carriage. Well-presented coat just needs to be harsher. Well-developed hindquarters. Short well boned legs well coated, strong round feet. Moved out and showed well and was so sound coming and going.

Limit Dog (2) 1 Tate's Jaeva Dream Come True: Small compact shape to this 18 month red in excellent harsh coat with good undercoat. Masculine look to his broad head with good width between his medium sized ears. Alert look to his dark eyes under nice eyebrows. Would like more stop. Correct wedge shape to his muzzle, little bit of summer nose. Proud head carriage on good moderate neck would like more ruff, well laid back shoulders, firm short back, correct erect tail position. Well angulated front and sprung ribs with good depth to body. Short strong legs and tight round feet, moved out well with good forward reach and rear drive from strong hindquarters.

Open Dog (2) 1 Gee's Ch Watercroft Boozy Miller: This kennel manages to produce a lovely type of animal and this is another who caught my attention on entering the ring. He has a real presence and showmanship. Holds a proud head carriage, which is correctly shaped, good width between his well-placed and used ears, defined stop separates his dark oval shaped alert eyes with a cheeky look, nice covering from his eyebrows. Strong wedge shaped muzzle correct dentition. Nice ruff to his moderate neck set well into laid back shoulders, firm short backline, rooted erect tail with happy action. Small build with a compact body having substance and good depth with sprung ribs. Correctly presented in a close red hard wiry textured jacket, correct undercoat. Well angulated front and rear with excellent muscle tone, short strongly boned legs, round well-padded feet. Very happy free easy mover with good reach and rear drive and so very sound. DCC, BOB. 2 Thompson-Morgan's Belleville High Life: Another well-built compact dog of small size and shape. Correctly rounded masculine head with nice width between his correctly set and dropped ears, defined stop, oval expressive eyes, slight brows. Medium length to strong neck good ruff around, well laid back shoulders firm level back to his rooted tail. Well angulated both ends of a compact body, well sprung ribs, lovely red jacket having a slightly longer length than my winner of wiry texture and lovely presentation. Short well boned legs and round tight feet. Moved out soundly a free mover. For a moment lost his confidence over something which slightly dropped his tail on the move, but once settled regained himself. Well worthy of RDCC.

Special Beginners Dog/Bitch (2) 1 Nash's Tiggy Of House Nash: Very attractive and feminine bitch, 4 years old a lovely, compact small size. Attractive slightly small but correctly furnished head, broad skull with good width between her dropped ears. Defined stop separates her oval shaped bright eyes. Correct balance to wedge shaped muzzle. Medium length to neck well laid back shoulders, with firm short back to a rooted erect tail. Nicely angulated compact well ribbed body covered in a nicely presented B/Tan wirey coat with good undercoat. Well-muscled throughout, good strong well boned short legs. Powerful mover with reach and rear driving action. BSB and winner of SBT. I understand she won the SB stakes. 2 Walker's Watercroft Golden Spice: Happy on the stance working well with er handler. I would like a little more strength to her pretty coated small head, having good width between her well set on ears. Would like more stop. Has a pretty expression to her dark eyes. Good length of neck slight ruff, firm longer backline with slight rise to her well rooted tail carried erect. Enough body with substance and well ribbed little long in loin. Well-presented and conditioned red wirey coat with correct undercoat. Straight short legs, round feet. Well angulated and muscled front and back which shows in her movement which is very sound with reach and powerful rear drive.

Veteran Bitch (2) 1 Lloyd's Orison Calm Attitude.

Minor Puppy Bitch (2) 1 Tate's Jaeva Bright As A Button: A delightful puppy who caught my attention as she entered the ring, full of character and a real showgirl with all the good breed points in one small package. Delightful head of correct size and shape, correctly hung ears, sweet alert dark eyes. Nice wedge shape to her muzzle with correct dentation. Good neck length laid back shoulders, firm straight short back to her erect tail. Correctly angled both ends of her small compact body, well ribbed back. Very well presented wiry wheaten jacket with good undercoat. Short well boned legs and small round feet, for her age, was so very sound and a positive mover with correct reach and powerful rear drive. BPB. Shortlisted in the Group. 2 Gee's Watercroft Treacle Toffee: I loved the look of this puppy, another with a character. A small compact build having a small broad feminine slightly rounded head, nice width between her ears, defined stop, pretty look to her expressive dark eyes small brows over. Correctly shaped wedged muzzle, correct dentition. Moderate neck to well laid back shoulders. Lovely firm and level short back well rooted erect tail. Correctly presented rich red jacket, wirey touch with good undercoat. Forequarters with well angled front to short legs well boned. Good body but I felt she was carrying too much weight which made her look a little too deep. Hindquarters with good angulation, short hocks, tight round feet. Sound mover with reach and drive. At 8 months has a good future.

Puppy Bitch (1) **1 Jenkins' Kinsridge Songbird:** 10 months young lady full of character enjoying her day out just needing to settle on the stance. Presented very well in a wiry rich wheaten coat with a nice undercoat. Feminine head of correct shape, positioned ears, defined stop, lovely dark alert eyes giving expression from under little eyebrows. Correct shape to her muzzle. Holds head proudly on a moderate length of neck, well laid back into her shoulders. Short back well held on the stance to her tail. Cobby body well ribbed back with short loin. Correctly angled both ends, short boned legs and round feet. Happy mover just needs to settle as rear movement has drive but little close, forward action is sound.

Junior Bitch (1) 1 Stevenson's Brickin Dare To Dream: An attractive 16 month old young bitch with a happy temperament enjoying her day out and standing well showing off a nice compact outline. Having a pretty correctly shaped head with good detail, a shaped skull and nicely hung ears. Good look to her dark alert eyes with slight brows. Holds herself well on a good neck well laid shoulders, good front angulation. Short level back well held to a rooted erect tail. A compact, cobby body in good condition with depth and well sprung ribs well back. Hindquarters well-muscled, good return of stifle and let down hocks. Good condition and presentation to the wiry texture of her wheaten jacket with nice undercoat. Short well boned legs, round feet a very positive movement with correct action.

Yearling Bitch (1) 1 Gee's Watercroft In The Que: This beautiful nearly 2 year old caught my eye as she entered the ring and did not disappoint in going over her. Lovely compact outline of the correct size and balanced shape, presented in a straight wiry textured jacket of a rich red. Love her delightful small head with her attractive eyebrows over her very expressive dark eyes set well, neatly hung ears. Correctly defined stop. Limited furnishing to her muzzle. Her neck fits well into her laid back shoulders, short, level back to her erect tail, over her cobby compact deep body so well ribbed back into her short loin. Well-muscled throughout, deep angled forechest, straight short well boned legs to round feet. Hindquarters strongly developed and turned stifle, well let down hocks. Had a very powerful, sound stylish free movement which she showed here and in the challenge which gave her the BCC, BOS.

Post Graduate Bitch (3) 1 Tate's Jaeva What The Hell: Stood working well with her handler this bitch completes the small compact picture I was looking for and going over has lots to like about her. Excellent head size and shape, nice skull and width between her hung ears, sweet dark alert eyes, correct wedge shape to her muzzle with slight furnishings. Nice neck length, correct depth of chest. Short straight level backline to her rooted erect tail, over a body with enough substance and good depth, well sprung ribs short loin. Very attractive, nicely presented in a conditioned well marked B/T wirey coat lying close, with correct undercoat. Quarters with good stifle and let down hocks. Short well boned legs and round feet. Moved out well with good flow front and back. RCC. 2 Jones' Javidel May Blessing At Darlaur: Another compact bitch of the correct size and compact build. Attractive on the stack this well marked B/T has a wirey coat that is not in quite the excellent presentation of my winner. Smart feminine head with a good skull, ear set could be better. Pretty dark kind oval eyes. Holds head well on a good length of neck, well set into shoulders into a short level back, and well held tail. Compact body carrying little too much extra weight showing in her depth and movement. Correctly angled front and rear, small well boned legs and small round feet. Moved happily but not with the power of the winner. 3 Watercroft Golden Spice.

Limit Bitch (3) 1 Jenkins' Kinsridge Tippy Toes: Very typical compactly built feminine bitch with a lovely outline on the stance. Small sweet correctly developed head, good skull well set on hung ears. Pretty dark eyes kind expression, correctly furnished wedged muzzle. Holds head proudly on medium neck slight ruff, set well into her laid back shoulders. Topline level to her short firm back well rooted erect tail. Body with substance and depth well sprung ribs back into short loin. Beautiful double wheaten coat with wirey texture and in excellent presentation. Short well boned legs and tight round feet, sound stylish free mover with reach and powerful rear action. One to watch. 2 Nash's Tiggy Of House Nash.

Open Bitch (1) 1 Gee's Watercroft Gold Leaf: Another beautiful bitch from this kennel, looked impressive across the ring and was just as nice to go over. Delightful smallish head, correct wide skull well hung ears. Bright keen dark oval eyes separated by a defined stop, wedge shaped muzzle, correctly furnished brows and beard. A proud head carriage held well on good neck length with slight ruff, which was set into laid-back shoulders. Has a short compact body, with firm level backline with a rooted erect tail. Her muscular body has substance and depth with sprung back ribs into a short loin. Beautiful presentation to her red wirey jacket of correct texture with a good undercoat. Lovely legs and feet, stylish mover who put on a good show. I looked at hard for the top honours but I had already fallen for her kennel mate In the Que.

The standard twice says they should be compact and short in back, so I was alarmed to find that the majority were too long in back, and some were too short on leg, so the outline wasn't typical. I do hope that breeders can correct this. Both CC winners were, in my opinion, the right shape making them very typical of this great little terrier.

Veteran Dog (1) **1 Nash's Ralph Of House Nash ShCEx:** Very good moving chunky d. He has a masculine head. Liked his length and strength of jaw. Enough neck. Well laid shoulder, slightly short in upper arm. Could be shorter in back. Well made rear. In super coat.

Minor Puppy Dog (1) **1 Ward's Littlemount Celyn Y Mor:** Very happy pup coming into coat. Well-proportioned head with good jaw and big teeth. Could have more neck and a shorter back. Well laid shoulders. Ribs are well sprung. Liked his rear. Moved v well.

Puppy Dog (1) **1 Thompson-Morgan's Belleville Plum Picker:** Full of fun. Liked his head, ears can settle. Medium neck. Shoulder is ok. Well sprung ribs. Could be shorter in loin and back. He has a well bent stifle with low hocks, stands more parallel on floor than on the table. Went well.

Junior Dog (1) **1 Darnell's Jacquidon Hot Off The Press:** Excels in profile movement. He has a masc head. Could have darker eyes. Medium neck. His angulation is v well balanced. Well sprung ribs. Level topline. High set tail, carried on back. Could be tidier coming towards.

Limit Dog (6) 1 Thompson-Morgan's Belleville Expectation: Short backed d giving correct outline. Liked his head, well balanced. Eyes could be slightly darker. Lengthy neck. Well laid shoulder. Decent upper arm. Liked his spring

of rib. Short back with high set almost straight tail. Super rear which he really uses, v good profile action. CC, Champion on the day, well done. **2 Haydon's Earthtaw Lincoln:** Liked his short back. Masc head, eyes a bit wide apart. Strong jaw. Enough neck. Quite a good front. Well ribbed. Not the rear of 1. In v good coat. Balanced stride. **3 Mullan & McFadden's Watercroft Pop Muzik At Tamodan.**

Open Dog (2) 1 Gee's Ch Watercroft Boozy Miller: Shows so very well. He has excellent angulation front and rear and so moved so v well out and back and in profile. He has a good head. Lengthy neck. I found him rather long in loin so not as compact as ideal. He holds a firm topline. In super jacket. His construction and movement took him to RCC, just not the outline of the limit winner. 2 Thompson-Morgan's Belleville High Life: Liked him for type, being shorter than 1. Has a super head. Enough neck. Well laid shoulder. Could have better hind angulation and topline was sloping on the move. Rather giddy here.

Veteran Bitch (3) **1 Macartney's Nordalset Little Bit Of Sun For Ivrig VW:** The more cobby of these 2 grand ladies. She has a fem head and a lovely expression. Medium neck. Well angulated front and rear. Could carry less weight. Harsh coat. **2 Lloyd's Orison Calm Attitude:** She is just a bit longer than 1. Fem head with good eyes and ears. Medium neck. Well angulated. Low hocks. In harsh coat.

Puppy Bitch (3) Not much to separate the first 2. **1 Thompson-Morgan's Belleville Citation:** Very feminine pup. She has a well-proportioned head. Lengthy neck. Better shoulder than 2 and she is slightly shorter in loin. Well sprung ribs. Coat coming in. V good rear. BP. **2 Gee's Watercroft Treacle Toffee:** She has a well-balanced head. Lengthy neck. Deep chest. Fairly short in back. Well set tail angulation is well balanced. In v good coat.

A little short in neck, level top line. Super quality coat, perfectly presented. A little unsettled at times today.

Open Dog (1) **1 Gee's Ch Watercroft Boozy Miller**: This male shouts 'Norfolk Terrier' he excels in breed type. Excellent width of skull, strong muzzle, dark eye, for perfection would prefer a smaller ear. Strong, medium length of neck, level top line held on the move. So much has been written about him before not a lot left to say he is in excellent condition and gleaming coat. Worthy CC winner.

Thank you to the club and committee for inviting me to judge this very special show. An excellent entry of 60 dogs much to my delight. A few observations I would like to share, head type is very consistent and I was pleased to see that most had the black eye rims which finishes off the expression. Please focus on the fronts on this breed, this clearly has been a cross the breed bears for many years and I saw no progress is this. It almost got to a point that I was heavily forgiving loose front in favour of breed type and side gait class after class. I do feel the breed needs to focus on this as a priority.

Veteran Dog (1) **1 Nash's Ralph Of House Nash ShCEx VW**: 7 year old and beautifully groomed male, broad skull with a good stop, his eye is a little full, excellent ribbing moved ok.

Minor Puppy Dog (2) **1 Jenkins' Kinsridge Cash Is King:** correct skull to muzzle with enough skull, exceptionally good bite with large teeth, well set ribs and strong powerful hind quarters driving well from behind, would like a better front assembly.

Puppy Dog (4) **1 Jenkins' Kinsridge Cash Point:** so breed typical, he really filled my eye, in full coat, he is so well boned and bodied with that cobby outlook that defines the breed, excellent teeth, excellent lay of shoulder but still needs to firm a little in front, strong hindquarters. He must have a great future. Best Puppy Dog. **2 Gee's Watercroft Cuckoo Waltz:** longer cast than one, his head is developing well, a little short in upper arm, but excellent croup and set on, using his guarters to advantage.

Junior Dog (1) **1 Darnell's Jacquidon Hot Off The Press:** he is such a well-made dog, excellent forehand and lay of shoulder, well bodied with low set hocks, good ribbing with excellent coat texture, moved very soundly.

Yearling Dog (3) 1 Thompson-Morgan's Belleville Plum Picker: Top size male with a good eye and excellent mouth, scored on neck well set at the withers, good rib and quarters, his front movement let him down for further consideration in the challenge. 2 Harrison's Jacquidon Rich Tea: cobby dog who really holds his shape on the move and standing. He is of correct size and outline, sound hindquarters with a moderate stride, he is however a little full in eye for me and tends to fly his ears.

Special Beginners Dog (3) **1 Harrison's Jacquidon Rich Tea. 2 Powell's Watercroft Brown Boots**: of a bigger mould than the winner, I would like more strength to muzzle, and more depth to body, excellent eye and a clean front with good quarters to match.

Novice Dog (1) **1 Rayner & Healey's Watercroft Mark One**: full of spirit and gassy giving a good account of himself, draws a good picture stood, and scored in side gait.

Post Graduate Dog (3) **1 Haydon's Earthtaw Lincoln:** such a well-made dog on hands on inspection, excellent eye, neat ears with and a good neck, cobby outlook, just wished he strode out more on the move. **2 Harrison's Jacquidon Rich Tea.**

Limit Dog (4) 1 Thompson-Morgan's Belleville High Life: scored heavily on head type, good skull, strong muzzle and correct ratios, excellent eye and pigmentation, classy outline and presented well, bit upright in shoulder but has a lengthy upper arm, excellent quarters and set on behind, tends to stand so much on top of himself that he tends to slope his topline and yet holds it together moving, really scored in profile action RDCC. 2 Phillips' Blakens Specially Brewed: loved him for his correct breed type, he really does fill your eye stood, masterful presentation to a well maintained coat, his head is full of detail and his body cobby and solid, strong hindquarters, unfortunately today his front movement let him down which cost him the class.

Open Dog (2) **1 Atkinson's Moortop My Mark Again:** strong bodies male with excellent ribbing, excellent eye and pigmentation, strong powerful hindquarters, and scored in side gait, his front coming isn't ideal which discounted him from further consideration in the challenge.

Champions Dog (2) 1 Gee's Ch Watercroft Boozy Miller: fully mature male in peak condition and body score, excellent jacket and full ruff, draws a lovely picture stood, good head shape with enough skull and width to muzzle, well set shoulders with enough layback and length to upper arm, topline and tailset correct with excellent quarters, perhaps taking hair off from underneath will not make him appear a little too low to ground, where he scores is in profile his movement is low and driving with good ground cover and great propulsion DCC, unfortunately he went to

pieces in the challenge for BIS where his owner sensibly withdrew him for RBIS. **2 Smith's Ch Javidel Despicable May:** such a well-made dog he is to go over, balanced front and rear, excellent eye and clean in neck, very sound moving coming and going and in profile, not the finish in coat of the winner.

Veteran Bitch (2) 1 Macartney's Nordalset Little Bit Of Sun For Ivrig: she has a very nice head type, dark eye rims and well bodied, good mover in all directions. 2 Lloyd's Orison Calm Attitude: lighter framed than 1, but full of energy and attitude, excellent coat texture, giving the handler a hard time today.

Minor Puppy Bitch (2) 1 Tate's Jaeva Puzzle Piece: every once in a while, a special one is born and I feel this one is it. Today she shone, handled so expertly to get the best out of her, type, temperament, outline and movement in a package so young I thrilling to find, gorgeous head with a good stop already, correct eye and super expression, clean neck into high set withers, good layback and enough upper arm, long ribs and a topline and tailset to match, her movement is almost foot perfect, and in time she will keep firming up even more. Gassy in temperament and I hope she reaches the milestones to maturity to be remembered as one of the best. RBCC and BPIS. 2 Smith's Javidel Handmayds Tale: finer headed than 1 and could do with more underjaw, cobby outlook and needs to settle more on the move.

Puppy Bitch (6) **1 Gee's Watercroft Dawn Chorus:** certainly has that stamp of quality, scored in general proportions, excellent eye shape and pigment, neat ears, good coat and presentation, strong quarters, needs to firm up in front. **2 Stevenson's Brickin Country Charm:** a well bodied bitch with excellent quarters, using them to advantage, her coat was not her best today and needs to settle on the move.

Junior Bitch (4) **1 Thompson-Morgan's Belleville Citation:** she is of lovely type, cobby in body and low to ground, excellent eye and ears, strong quarters and an active gassy mover, going well in all directions. **2 Tate's Jaeva Bright As A Button:** gorgeous head and expression, small dark eye and good pigmentation, correct muzzle to skull, draws a lovely outline stood, was very unsettled on the move and tended to side wind which cost her the class.

Yearling Bitch (3) 1 Atkinson's Moortop Bobby's Girl: quality bitch with an ok head, needs more stop for finish, excellent coat texture, and beautifully made body, moving so accurately in all directions. 2 Smith's Javidel Oh Me Oh May: certainly carrying an extra pound or two, ok head but would like more strength to muzzle, excellent hindquarters, front needs to firm.

Special Beginners Bitch (2) **1 Nash's Tiggy Of House Nash:** correct for size, with excellent coat texture, good dark eye, rather domed in skull, excellent front assembly and movement to match. **2 Mason's Tidy Dancer Around Nosam:** went better in this class than when she was in yearling, good eye would like a shorter muzzle.

Novice Bitch (3) **1 Hess & Higgins' Umbrage Special Delivery**: nice for outline with strong hindquarters, moving a bit wide in front. **2 Mason's Tidy Dance Around Nosam.**

Post Graduate Bitch (5) **1 Stevenson's Brickin Dare To Dream:** won the class on her lovely type and size, enough stop and would like a smaller eye, scored in body proportions and so well ribbed, strong quarters needs to firm up in front, very good tail set and carriage. **2 Phillips' Blakens Catch The Stars:** scored on head, correct muzzle to skull ratios excellent eye, strong quarters.

Limit Bitch (7) 1 Gee's Watercroft In The Que: beautifully presented and handled, excellent proportions, small and dark eye, enough muzzle, well-made front, cobby outlook with strong quarters, a real contender in the challenge. 2 Jenkins' Kinsridge Tippy Toes: scored on her broad skull, fabulous teeth, must comment and say every dog this kennel showed had full complete scissor bites with big teeth, touch heavy in shoulder but strong quarters, not the reach and drive of the winner.
